THE CADENT GAS LIMITED (WHASSETT TO BARROW HIGH PRESSURE GAS PIPELINE DIVERSION) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2023

GENERAL VESTING DECLARATION

This **GENERAL VESTING DECLARATION** is executed on the 27thday of August by Cadent Gas Limited ("the Authority").

WHEREAS:

- On 7 June 2024 an order entitled The Cadent Gas Limited (Whassett to Barrow High Pressure Gas Pipeline Diversion) Compulsory Purchase Order 2023 ("the Order") was confirmed by the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero under the powers conferred on him by the Gas Act 1986 authorising the Authority to acquire the new rights specified in column (2) of Part 1 of the Schedule hereto and described in Part 2 of the Schedule hereto over the plots of land respectively specified and described in column (1) of Part 1 of the Schedule hereto.
- (2) Notice of the confirmation of the Order was first published in accordance with section 15 of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 on 20 June 2024.
- (3) That notice included the statement and form prescribed under section 15(4)(e) and (f) of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH that, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 4 of the Compulsory Purchase (Vesting Declarations) Act 1981 ("the Act"), the Authority hereby declare –

- (1) The rights described in column (2) of Part 1 of the Schedule hereto (being the new rights authorised to be acquired by the Order) and more particularly delineated on the plan annexed hereto, together with the right to enter and take possession of the new rights shall vest in the Authority as from the end of the period of 3 months from the date on which the service of notices required by section 6 of the Act is completed.
- (2) The rights vested in the Authority by this Declaration ("the Vested Rights") shall be exercisable by the Authority for the benefit of:
 - a. the freehold property of the Authority being land at Canal Head, Canal Street, Ulverston registered at HM Land Registry under title number CU175386;
 - b. each and every part of the Whassett to Barrow High Pressure Gas Pipeline Diversion project in respect of which the Order was made; and
 - c. the corporeal and incorporeal property comprised in the business undertaking of the Authority (the "Authority's Undertaking")

to the intent that the Vested Rights may be exercised by both the Authority, its successors in title assigns, lessees and those deriving title from them and all persons authorised by any of these in respect of the whole or any part of such property whether it is comprised in the Authority's Undertaking or the business undertaking of any successor in title or statutory successor or assignees.

(3) For the purposes of section 2(2) of the Act, the specified period in relation to the new rights comprised in the declaration is one year and one day.

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- (4) The Authority hereby requests that the Chief Land Registrar:
 - a. note the benefit of the Vested Rights acquired by the Authority by this declaration in the Property Register of the Acquiring Authority's freehold property of the Authority

- being land at Canal Head, Canal Street, Ulverston registered at HM Land Registry under title number CU175386 as soon as possible following the Vesting Date;
- b. note the burden of any Vested Rights acquired by the Authority by this declaration in relation to a particular Plot in the Property Register of each owner's registered title relating to that Plot as soon as possible following the Vesting Date; and
- c. where the Plot in question is not registered land, to create a caution against such land protecting the Vested Rights acquired by the Authority by this declaration as soon as possible following the Vesting Date.

- b) store, stockpile and where necessary use, manage and process plant, machinery, apparatus, materials (including excavated material) and/or equipment;
- access the land and adjoining land with or without vehicles, personnel and plant, machinery, apparatus, equipment and materials for such purposes;
- d) fence, erect hoardings or signage or otherwise secure the compound;
- e) carry out de-watering and drainage works and install, alter or reinstate land drainage systems;
- f) discharge water into existing drains and watercourses;
- g) install, use and remove artificial lighting;
- h) park cars;
- protect and prevent damage to or interference with the operation and maintenance of any works constructed pursuant to these Construction Compound Rights;
- fell, trim or lop trees, shrubs, hedges and bushes and to clear and remove any and all vegetation which may damage, obstruct or interfere with the exercise of these Construction Compound Rights;
- k) prevent and remove any works or use of the land which may interfere with or obstruct the exercise of these Construction Compound Rights;
- l) install, use, alter, divert and remove services and utilities;
