

Changes to Quotation Acceptance – Request for provision of site contact details

This briefing note is to ask IGT's & UIP's to start providing end consumer details upon quote acceptance when requested.

From 1st December 2020 Cadent will be implementing Network Exit Agreement's (NExA's) within our networks for customers with sites which fall within the following classifications:

- Power generation, frequency demand customers
- Sensitive exit loads on the network
- Very Large Daily Metered Consumer (VLDMC) exit loads on the network

The NExA agreement will clarify the customers obligations when taking gas from the network as well as Cadent's obligations as a Gas Transporter.

Included is some high-level background detail in the event you would like to have a conversation with your customer prior to supplying their details to Cadent. The NExA will contain the following details;

- the agreed Supply Hourly Quantity (SHQ)
- the ramp rate in which gas can be taken from the network
- details if the site is a Frequency Response site, and who the Grid Operator is
- details on maintenance periods including the notification for these periods

On a monthly basis, sites will be asked to provide Cadent with the following information;

- the actual rate of offtake of gas during each minute of each day
- the maximum and minimum pressure measurement at the emergency control valve (ECV) for each day
- the peak6 measurement on each given day and at what time it occurred

Any quote that is issued after 1st December 2020 will include an additional sheet for you to populate the end consumers details on, this is so Cadent can have the relevant conversations with the right people before we enter into a NExA. We would therefore ask that when you return your quote acceptance that you also include the additional sheet provided.
